This qualification reflects the role of workers in the community and/or residential setting who follow an individualised plan to provide person centered support to those in aging or who have a disability. Work involves using discretion and judgment in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs.

Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

To achieve this qualification, the candidate must have completed at least 120 hours of work placement.
